



Chuck Howarth Announces Retirement

Chuck Howarth, Chairman of the National Foundation for Unemployment Compensation and Workers' Compensation (The Foundation) recently announced his retirement from his position as Senior Vice President and Executive Director of the Unemployment Insurance Division of the California Association of Hospitals & Health Systems.

Chuck is also retiring from his position as Chairman of the Foundation and from his position on the Board of Directors of UWC – Strategic Services on Unemployment & Workers' Compensation (UWC). He served on the UWC Board and the Board of UBA, the predecessor to UWC, going back to 1991.

In his position on the UWC Board and as Chairman of the Foundation, Chuck served as a leading voice for business in Unemployment Insurance, actively participating in legislative and policy development at the national level as well as serving as a UI expert for the business community in California.

In 2004 Chuck was awarded the J. Eldred Hill, Jr. by his peers the first year after the award was first presented. The award is named after J. Eldred Hill, Jr., former president of UWC (then UBA). The award is given to an individual for excellence in the public policy arena in service to the employer community.
