We expect the testimony to focus on best practices of state workforce agencies in addressing ways to assist unemployed workers in returning to work, including a wide of range of strategies, including expanded work search, reemployment and eligibility assistance, short-time compensation, self-employment assistance, and targeted education and training for unemployed workers.

Best practices identified in the hearing may be incorporated in legislation addressing unemployment issues that is expected to be considered before the end of the year.
