






## State Information Data Exchange System

Created through a partnership with NASWA USDOL, states and third-party administrators









SIDES provides a secure, electronic tool for employers to quickly, accurately, and securely respond to state unemployment insurance information requests.



- Electronic notifications
- Receive individual claim potential charges
- Confirm UI Agency receipt
- Report missed separation issues



- Standard format all SIDES users will recognize
- Easy to implement
- Faster notice of appeals



- Daily breakdown of wages
- Input earnings based on payroll week
- SIDES calculates wages for benefit week



- Receive quarterly or annual charging notices
- Information secure
- Postage savings for responses/protests


